### The scholarship

- One scholarship is available, starting in August 2017.
- The scholarship provides full tuition fees, a return economy flight, an arrival allowance and a regular stipend (living allowance).
- The scholarship is for Master's study only and is not applicable to a distance learning course.
- The scholarship is for a new student only and cannot be used to fund a course you have already started.
- No additional funding will be provided for applicants with families.
- The scholarship is for a maximum of one year.

### Eligibility

- Applicants must be a citizen of a [Commonwealth country](#) *other than* Anguilla, Antigua and Barbuda, The Bahamas, Barbados, Bermuda, British Virgin Islands, Cayman Islands, Dominica, Grenada, Jamaica, Montserrat, St Christopher's (St Kitts) and Nevis, St Lucia, St Vincent and the Grenadines, Trinidad and Tobago, and the Turks and Caicos Islands.
- Applicants must hold a Bachelors degree of at least upper second level.
